For cancellation charges related to group bookings, partial ship charters or full ship charters refer to your charter contract or group booking agreement for terms and conditions.

If police or any other authority in any jurisdiction notify us of, or we otherwise become aware of any matter that reasonably causes us to believe your presence onboard presents a risk to your own health or safety or the health and safety of other guests and crew, we, or the Captain may deny you boarding. A full refund will be provided to any guest denied boarding on this basis. Once the cruise has commenced, if a guest seriously affects the safety, well-being or enjoyment of themselves or any other person onboard, the Captain has the right to confine, sedate or disembark the guest. In such cases, we will not provide a refund and we are not responsible for any expenses including your return home. While the Captain will always act reasonably in these circumstances, you accept that the safety, well-being and enjoyment of everyone onboard comes first.

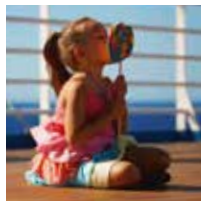
