Your booking is not secure until we receive a deposit. Deposits must be received within three (3) days from the date the booking is made. If payment is not received within this time, your booking will be automatically cancelled. Once we have received payment on a booking, a legally binding agreement on the Carnival Cruise Ticket Contract becomes effective between all guests on the booking(s) and Carnival plc.

Depending on the proximity of the sailings or availability of inventory, full deposit or final payment may be required sooner. All guests on the same booking must travel on the same fare type. From time to time, we may release promotional fares that have different payment conditions. Please ensure you check the payment conditions at time of booking.
